



Deferred Pension Payment Request Form Paying your Deferred Pension between age 55 and 75

You can choose to take payment of your deferred pension between age 55 and 75 without needing permission from your previous employer. If you take payment of your deferred pension before your Normal Pension Age (NPA) it may be lowered as it will be paid early. If you take payment of your deferred pension after your NPA it may be increased as it will be in paid to you later. If you want to access your deferred pension on the grounds of ill health you should speak to your previous employer.

We will send you figures for your deferred pension based on the date given on the form. We will also send a retirement pack which you will need to fill in and send back to us if you want to be paid your deferred pension. If you decide to take payment of your pension we will backdate your pension payment to the **Requested Estimate Date** on your form.

If you have more than one deferred pension you will need to fill in a separate form for each deferred pension you want to be paid
